

# Foothills Area Family Y on the move again

SENECA — A year since relocating from its longtime headquarters at the Y Beach in Clemson, the Foothills Area Family YMCA is on the move again.

Executive Director Anna Connelly announced Monday that the organization has moved from its Keowee River headquarters to a new office located inside the Rankin Real Estate building — just east of the U.S. 123 and S.C. 130 intersection.

“With the growth of the Foothills YMCA over the past year comes the need for an office move,” Connelly said. “This move has taken place for convenience and better visibility for our program participants now and for new YMCA members of the future.”

Connelly added that factors in the move included the Y’s offering after school care in seven schools, spring soccer registration that is currently under way and the upcoming launch of its capital campaign.

“This location on the highly traveled 123 will give us the needed flexibility for those we serve now and also serve as a great way to introduce ourselves to those who don’t know there is a YMCA in Oconee,” she said.

Connelly, who thanked Keowee River Development for its generosity in allowing the organization to operate rent and utility free while housed on their property, said a decision regarding a future YMCA facility site has yet to be made.
