Chairman Ryan Honea has enjoyed his one-year stint with the gavel.

Whether he gets to hold on to it will depend on the pleasure of the sevenmember group when it elects offi-

cers at Monday night's meeting. "It's their choice," Honea said Friday. "If the members so wish, I would stay on."

Honea said he plans to ask the group for their nominations from the floor.

"Now's the time, if they don't like me, for them to vote me out," he added.

The Commission meeting begins at 6 p.m.

Honea, of Fair Play, is the District 5 representative on the Commission.

He has served on the board since 1995 and sat as the vice chairman on various occasions. He has one year left on his current term.

Once his term is completed

Honea said he has no idea whether another appointment would be forthcoming. It is up to the District 5 Oconee County Council member to fill the position.

District 5 Councilman Reg Dexter is up for re-election this year and Honea said he doesn't know whether Dexter will run.

Howard Moore of District 2 is the Commission's vice chairman. His position also will be up for grabs.

Included on the Commission's agenda is discussion and consideration of the group's goals in 2012, which have not yet

been made public.

A workshop to continue the ongoing review and suggested changes to the Zoning Enabling Ordinance follows the business meeting.

Honea said the Commission is close to completing the review and would personally like to see it "put to bed" in February. He said it would be up to County Council to decide whether to adopt the proposed changes.

"They may reject everything," Honea said. "We won't know until we get it to them."
