Wade said a softball field is being built at Ponderosa Park with, in round numbers, a \$28,000 grant from the state Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism and an \$8,000 match from county recreation funds.

Wade said work has already started and the field could be ready by this fall.

He said the town also received about \$80,000 from C-Fund money that is being used to add about 60 parking spaces. They already have about 120 park-
