More than 2.5 inches of rain fell Friday at Greenville-Spartanburg International Airport, making for a wet end to

a soggy work week, according to the National Weather Service in Greer.

As showers moved out of the area, the chance of rain for Saturday was 20 percent and a high of 80, said

Weather Service meteorologist Larry Gabric.

More than six inches of rain fell this week, he said.

Thursday's total was 2.5 inches, and 1.13 inches fell on Wednesday, Gabric said.
