
4 hurt after pontoon, DNR boat collide on Keowee

SENECA — Four people have been hurt after a South Carolina wildlife agency boat collided with a pontoon on Memorial Day.

Department of Natural Resources spokesman Robert McCullough told news outlets the crash happened about 3:15 p.m.

Monday on Lake Keowee near Seneca.

McCullough said the officer and one person in the pontoon were thrown into the water. They were taken to the hospital with injuries that did not appear life-threatening.

McCullough said the officer was on patrol. No other information has been released.
