

Clemson offers 'tailgazing' spaces for eclipse

CLEMSON — Those making their way to the "Eclipse Over Clemson" event on Aug. 21 for the total solar eclipse have the chance to reserve their own personal spots to enjoy the historic event.

At a cost of \$50, the school is offering "tailgazing" spots at the Snow Family Outdoors Fitness and Wellness Center. There are 900 spaces available for use from 10 a.m. until 6 p.m., and the proceeds will go toward enhancing the site, locat-

ed on the shores of Lake Hartwell.

Each space will also come with five pairs of solar glasses to help safely watch the eclipse, which will last from 1:07-4:02 p.m., with the period of totality beginning at 2:37 p.m. and lasting, fittingly

enough, two minutes and 37 seconds.
