## Motorists can expect delays Thursday morning on SC 130

### Duke to move transformer from Newry to storage site

SENECA — Duke Energy is planning to move a Keowee Hydro Station transformer from its location at the Newry railroad spur to its storage location on site starting at 8 a.m. Thursday.

The transformer will move from Newry up S.C. Highway 130, a process that will take ap-

proximately four hours to complete, according to Duke Energy South Carolina communications manager Chris Rimel. The highway will be open to traffic, with only one lane for passing the unit while in motion. Duke recommends using alternate routes and says drivers should expect delays in the area at the time of the move.

In the event the movement cannot be completed Thursday, Friday is the alternate date.

"Please expect that travel durations will be increased due to the lane closures and make the necessary arrangements to allow for road and sidewalk blockages and the longer wait times," Rimel said in an email.
