WAHALLA—Oconee Heritage Center's Capturing History photo contest is open to photographers of all ages, with a submission deadline set for 5 p.m. July 19.

Photos will be displayed July 21-Aug. 4 at the Heritage Center, located at 123 Brown Square Drive in Walhalla, and on its Facebook page. The top 12 photographs that receive the most votes will be arranged in a 2018 calendar to benefit OHC, according to its July calendar of events.

Photographs of historic subjects, such as historic sites, historic buildings, old homes, old farms, living history and historic artifacts, are all eligible to participate, as long as the photos capture places in Oconee County.

Entrants must gain permission from property owners before photographing a private property. OHC does not condone trespassing or privacy violations.

If interested, entrants must submit an 8-by-10-inch copy of their photograph mounted on foam board and a digital copy, and bring the photograph to the location listed above during normal business hours by July 19.

All photographs should accurately reflect the subject matter and the scene as it appeared, and they should not be digitally altered beyond standard optimization. No watermarks or Photoshop work are allowed.
