Fall for Greenville is just over two months away, and we now know who will be playing the stages throughout the annual event.

The 2017 BB&T Fall for Greenville presented by Pepsi music lineup was announced Sunday on the Fall for Greenville Facebook page, though one surprise remains. The Saturday night headliner is not yet announced.

The lineup includes more

than 70 bands that will play on six stages across Downtown Greenville. Some local highlights include Mac Arnold & Plate Full O' Blues, Kylie Odetta, Deads 27s, TJ Lazer and more.

Billed as "the Southeast's most popular outdoor festival", the annual event in downtown Greenville highlights food and music. Dozens of local vendors will be on hand serving more than 200 menu items.

Tickets to Fall for Greenville are free, which means visitors can hear all of the music at no cost, but food will have to be purchased with Taste Tickets. Tickets can be bought at fallforgreenville.net now, or at the festival.
