

Fall Creek litter pickup a success

WALHALLA — Since May 15, there have been 90 citations for various charges — including littering, alcohol and drug violations, public disorderly conduct and minor in possession of alcohol — at Fall Creek Landing.

And on Saturday, 25 offenders reported to the recreation area to pick up litter as part of their sentencing in lieu of paying fines, spending close to two hours picking up 980 pounds of litter, according to a news release from the Oconee County Sheriff's Office.

The areas the pickup took place — Fall Creek One and Two, as well as the Rock — are county

recreation areas under the jurisdiction of the sheriff's office, whose officers patrol the area on foot and on the water.
