

Salem approves waterline extension to Cliffs

SALEM — The Cliffs North is set to offer 39 new lakefront lots after recently being approved for a 1-mile waterline extension.

Salem director of

operations Ryan Hardin told town council the extension on Old Chapman Bridge Road was approved by the S.C. Department of Health and Environmental Control.

He estimated it would take workers three to four weeks for the exten-

sion to be in service, and that lots would become available for purchase in the spring. The surveying work for the project is complete, Hardin said. It's about a mile of 6-inch duct waterline added to the system, he said.

Hardin added there

will be no cost to the town for the extension and that it came from Cliffs Land LLC.

The lines will be deeded over to Salem when work is completed, Hardin said.
