Oconee County switches deed search software

WALHALLA — The Oconee County register of deeds office has moved its online record search to a new system to avoid a lapse in coverage.

The previous software,
Resolution, was being phased
out out over the next few years,
Oconee County registrar Anna
Davison said, so the county
made the decision to change to
RecordHub.

"There's a few changes on our end as far as indexing and verifying and things like that," Davison said. "As far as searching, they can just go in and do an advanced search, simple search or search by book and page — things like that — just like before."

The system is still free to use, she said, but does require a basic account setup,

"You do have to set up a username and password," she added. "There is no charge for this service—it's free for anybody to use."
