

# Keowee Key opens Chestnut Point Park

SALEM — Keowee Key residents have another community amenity to celebrate after a grand opening ceremony was held for an outdoor activity area last week.

On Friday, community officials opened the Chestnut Point Park. The park features eight shuffleboard courts and two bocce courts, according to a news release from Keowee Key. The park also includes a covered pavilion, seating, grills and picnic tables with a view of Lake Keowee.

“Outdoor activities are fantastic additions to our community,” board president Kevin Minton said in the release. “We have provided sports that allow enjoyment outdoors just in time for those who are emerging from being
