

DHEC plans free Oconee vaccine clinic

SENECA — A free COVID-19 vaccine clinic will be open in Oconee County next Tuesday.

The S.C. Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) will be operating the clinic at the Blue Ridge Community Center at 315 Holland Ave. in Seneca on April 13.

Appointments must be made to receive a shot, as no walk-ins will be accepted. A second vaccine shot will be given on May 11. An appointment can be made by calling DHEC at (864) 482-1867.

All South Carolinians 16 and older are eligible for the vaccine.

According to DHEC, 22,390 Oconee County residents had received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine as of Monday.
