

School district launches new app

WALHALLA — The School District of Oconee County launched a smart device app on Thursday.

The app is available for both Apple and Android devices, according to a news release from the district.

News, events and athletic information for the district and each school are available within the app.

District spokeswoman Jennifer Dodd said the app is an extension of the district's new website

platform, which launched in July.

The app has direct links to the more popular pages on the website, such as COVID-19 information, school calendars, athletic ticket sales and lunch menus.

Some features of the app and website, like the student portal, are still under

development, but Dodd said the district is adding content "as quickly as we can."

Parents and students will eventually be able to access their respective portals through the app as well.



TO DOWNLOAD THE APP

- Search "Oconee Schools SC" in the device's app store and download the app.
 - Open the app and click on the "More" menu in the bottom right corner.
 - Click "My Schools" at the top. Select "School District of Oconee County" and then choose one or more schools.
 - To turn on notifications, click the "More" menu, click "Notifications" and then the gear icon at the top.
