

Construction to begin for CU Tiger Walk

CLEMSON — Construction work for Clemson University's Tiger Walk will shut down the entire C-3 parking lot beginning Nov. 28.

The lot has 823 parking spots and is located directly across from Jervey Athletic Center in front of Memorial Stadium's West End Zone.

Also known as Lot 5 during athletic events and largely for commuting students, the lot will be re-paved and re-lotted, with trees and other features also set to be added.

Once the Tiger Walk project is completed, almost 700 commuters will be able to return to parking in the C-3 parking lot. Safety and security items such as added lighting, safe pedestrian walkways and security cameras will have been installed.

With the West End Zone parking lot closed for construction, participants and visitors attending
