BorgWarner to Expand South Carolina Facility, Add Battery Pack Production

BorgWarner plans to invest \$42 million in building and equipment upgrades and development of new manufacturing lines for its Seneca, S.C., production facility,

contributing to the growth of the company's battery module and pack production in the U.S.

Company officials said the investment will be allocated to building and equipment upgrades as well as the development of new manufacturing lines to launch the production of 3GWh of annual battery module capacity.

Over the course of three years, the expansion is expected to create approximately 122 jobs, including production, technical support, manufacturing, engineering, maintenance and supporting function positions.

To aid in the expansion, BorgWarner said it is working closely with the state of South Carolina as well as Oconee County.

"The ability to expand our existing BorgWarner operations producing energy-efficient, clean products is crucial as we continue to 'Charge Forward' toward our goal of enabling lower-emissions transportation," said Volker Weng, vice president and general manager, BorgWarner Drivetrain and Battery Systems.

Expansion of the facility is slated to begin in the second quarter of 2023, with an expected completion date of in the first half of 2024.
